2018 RESIDENT PARKING PASSES

LaVern Johnson and Bohn Park resident parking passes

2017 Parking Passes expire on December 31st. The 2018 parking passes for LaVern Johnson and Bohn Park are available to residents of Lyons (utility billing customers only). One free resident parking pass per household, second pass may be obtained for \$35, third pass will be \$55. Golf carts are considered vehicles. The one free parking pass per household may be used for golf cart.

Sign up for a 2018 resident parking pass on the Town of Lyons website www.townoflyons.com/parkingpass. Non-residents may purchase a season parking pass for a flat rate of \$75 per vehicle. The parking fee for 2018 is currently set at \$5 for every 4 hours and may be paid at the kiosks located throughout the parks with the receipt placed on the windshield. Parking fees are enforced.

Hockey Hours: Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday 4pm- 9pm and
Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 10am - 4pm

Please be aware of the skill level and safety of others while skating. Please do not play hockey during family recreational skating hours.

*Skate Rentals will be available at the LaVern Johnson Park Concession Stand Saturday & Sundays from 12 pm - 4 pm, when the ice skating rink is open. Ice skate rental returns may be placed in the ice skate drop box located outside of the concession stand.

NOTE: All times are subject to change without notice.

Skate Rental Prices:

1 Day Rental (Return by end of same day):
Lyons Residents = \$8.00 | Non-Residents = \$10.00

1 Week Rental (Return by the end of same day the following week):
Lyons Residents = \$20.00 | Non-Residents = \$25.00

There is no charge to use the rink at LaVern Johnson Park. However, parking fees are in effect. Perfect time to sign up for your parking pass for 2018! And remember use the ice rink at YOUR OWN RISK.

Volunteers from the State of Colorado Division of Wildlife will be teaching a hunter education course.

In Colorado, any hunter born after January 1, 1949 is required to take a 15-hour course. Hunter Education certificates are valid in all states and are good for life (unless laws are violated). Areas to be touched on during the course include: survival, ethics, conservation, wildlife management, the law, field care of game, game identification, and the philosophy of hunting.
