FATS, OILS AND GREASE

A byproduct of cooking, grease comes from meat fats, oil, shortening, butter, food scraps, baking goods, sauces and dairy products. When washed down the sink, grease sticks to the insides of sewer pipes (both on your property and in the streets) Over time, it can build up and block the entire pipe. It can also be a problem for the Town of Lyons' sewage collection and treatment system.

Help prevent sewer issues/overflow:

- Never pour grease down sink drains or into toilets.
- Scrape grease and food scraps into a container or trash for disposal.
- Put strainers to catch food scraps and other solids, emptying them into trash.
- Do not use the toilet for disposal of food scraps, sanitary items, rags, cloths or towels.

Keep these foods out of all drains!

Meat Fats (bacon, sausage)

Lard

Cooking Oil, butter or margarine

Food scraps

Baking products

Milk, ice cream, yogurt, sour cream

Cream based sauces, salad dressings, cheeses, mayonnais
