Boulder County Parks & Open Space will send email and text alerts when trails open and close. Users can sign up to receive notifications directly at boco.org/trailalerts

Trails close due to muddy conditions, seasonal wildlife closures, or other safety reasons. Closure alerts are posted on the Parks & Trails page, individual property page, and the Trail Closures, Alerts & Conditions page.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK TIMED ENTRY SYSTEM

Timed Entry Permit Reservations are required, along with a park pass or entrance fee, to enter Rocky Mountain National Park from May 26 to October 22, 2023.

There are two different access options for timed entry permits in 2023, access with Bear Lake Road (Park Access+) and access without Bear Lake Road (Park Access). For complete details for you or your visitors this summer, visit www.nps.gov/romo/index.htm

LYONS FLYER ADDS MID-DAY ROUTE

The Lyons Flyer provides FREE weekday transit service between the Town of Lyons and Boulder.

For two months, July 5 to August 31, 2023, Boulder County will add a midday round trip between Lyons and Boulder. The added times leave Boulder at noon, heading to Lyons and leaving Lyons at 12:50 pm, headed to Boulder. Don't forget that the service is free! No pass is required. TREE LIMB PICK-UP

The Town of Lyons will be working with Baer Forestry to pick up tree limbs **within the town limits for residents with less than one acre** on Monday, July 17 and Tuesday, July 18. They will be working from the North side of Town to the South side of Town.

- Branches and limbs ONLY. No grass, weeds, loose yard waste, or compost. It will not be picked up.
- No construction debris or treated lumber. No nails or wire in limbs. It will not be picked up.
- Limbs and branches should be placed curbside by 7:00 am on Monday, July 17 in order to be picked up.
- Limbs should be cut as straight as possible. Limbs must be less than 6" diameter and all cuts facing the same direction-toward the street.
- Place limbs into stacks. Neighbors are requested to consolidate where possible. Piles should be of reasonable size and orderly as possible.
- Limbs should be placed off the sidewalk and with enough access for the chipper.
- Limbs will not be collected in alleys. Even if your trash/recycling collection occurs in an alley, you must place limbs curbside in front of your property for pick-up.



LYONS COMMUNITY FOUNDATION GRANTS

The Lyons Community Foundation (LCF) is pleased to announce their 16th Annual Community Support granting season. Applications for Community Support Grants are available to all local non-profit organizations, beginning August 1st. Submissions are due on September 9, 2023. Electronic submissions are required; granting information and applications are available at lyonscf.org.

Over the lifetime of the Community Support Grants program, LCF has awarded more than half a million dollars in grant awards. This year, nearly \$50,000 will be made available to deserving recipients.
