Details are being worked out and finalized throughout this month, but save the weekend of September 9 and 10 for tours, music, potlucks, formal and informal get togethers as we remember our Grit, Grace and Gratitude.



## BROADWAY ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

In early August, Mountain Constructors will begin mobilization as the contractor selected to make improvements to Broadway. Similar to the improvements made to Main Street over a decade ago, the overall plan is to narrow the travel lanes, add parallel parking, sidewalks, curb extensions, a separate multi modal lane and upgrade the travel corridor. Construction is scheduled to last through the fall, with one lane closures Monday through Friday.
