PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

RTD has fully migrated over to the MyRide App, to be used with your smart phone for all passes. This means the EcoPass card is no longer valid and Lyons residents need to download and install the MyRide app, in order to access free use of any RTD bus and light rail including rides to the airport, and around Boulder, Longmont, and Denver. BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR!

With winter upon us, remember commercial and residential sidewalks are required to be cleared within 24 hours after a snowstorm.

WINTER ICE BUILD-UP

In Lyons it is not uncommon for daytime temperatures to reach into the upper 30s and 40s following a snowstorm, causing the snow to melt quickly. The snowmelt runs down the gutter along the street until it is collected by a storm drain inlet or catch-basin. Shaded areas (often north facing) are particularly problematic, as pavement temperatures tend to be about 20 degrees colder than areas exposed to the sun. When snow in the gutter partially melts, then freezes at night in the shadow of trees or structures before reaching a storm drain inlet, icing occurs. The repeated daytime warming and night-time freezing creates the accumulation of ice along the gutter. Please be mindful of these areas in the winter months.

RESIDENT PARKING PASS

The annual parking pass for the parks in Lyons, including LaVern Johnson and Bohn Park is available to residents of Lyons (utility billing customers only). One resident parking pass per household is free to residents (within town limits), a second pass may be obtained for \$40, and three or more are \$55 each additionally. Please note that golf carts are considered vehicles and the one free parking pass may be used for a golf cart.

Non-residents may purchase a season parking pass for a flat rate of \$80 per vehicle. The parking fee for 2024 remains at \$2 per hour on weekdays and off-season weekends, and \$3 per hour on peak-season weekends. Hourly parking fees can be paid at the kiosks located throughout the parks, with the receipt placed on the windshield. Parking fees are enforced daily.
