GOLF CAR REGISTRATION

All Golf Cars (Low Speed Electric Vehicles) shall be registered in Lyons, per the Lyons Municipal Code. Remember to register a golf car to help ensure the vehicle is safe and has the correct mirrors and signage required. The program is for the safety of drivers as well as residents. APRIL DISCOUNT DOG DAYS

Per the Lyons Municipal Code, all residents living in the Town must obtain a license for their dog. It is essential for identifying lost dogs, vaccination verification, and for peace of mind in the community. Visit townoflyons.com/dog to get your dog licensed.

1st dog license: \$30.00...but with the discount only \$20.00

2nd dog licenses: \$20.00... but with the discount only \$15.00

The town will need proof of your dog's current rabies vaccination. Please bring an extra copy for the town to keep. You are welcome to come to Town Hall with your proof of vaccination and complete the paperwork to license your dog. Remember to leash your dog too!



DID YOU KNOW?

Vehicles left unattended or unmoved on public property or right of way for longer than seven days must be removed or stored in an enclosed structure (LMC 10-4-70(c)).

EMERGENCY SIREN TESTING

Boulder County has begun testing of the countywide emergency sirens in April. The audible siren tests take place on the first Monday of each month, from April through September and occur twice on each testing day, at 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Siren tests ensure that all systems and procedures are working properly during the season of peak flood and fire danger. Should Boulder County experience severe weather during one of the planned audible tests, the siren tests for that day may be cancelled.

2024 PARKING PASS

Parking passes for both LaVern Johnson and Bohn Park are available to residents of the Town of Lyons. One free resident parking pass per household. Golf cars are considered vehicles. Non-residents may purchase a season parking pass for a flat rate of \$80 per vehicle. Sign up for your 2024 resident parking pass: townoflyons.com/parkingpass

The parking fee for 2024 is currently set at \$2 per hour on weekdays and off-season weekends, and \$3 per hour on peak-season weekends. Parking fees can be paid at the kiosks located throughout the parks. Place the receipt on the windshield. Parking fees are enforced every day.
