

EMERGENCY SIREN TESTING

Boulder County has begun testing of the county emergency sirens. The audible siren tests take place on the first Monday of each month, from April through September and occur twice on each testing day at 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Siren tests ensure that all systems and procedures are working properly during the season of peak flood and fire danger.

DID YOU KNOW?

It is illegal to block a sidewalk with your vehicle. Refrain from parking across a sidewalk – you could be preventing someone with a disability or a child from making their way safely through town.

Wet wipes are not flushable? Nationwide, more than \$1 billion in damage occurs annually from the flushing of wet wipes. Please do your part and throw them in the trash not the toilet!

HELPFUL UPDATES

- Each year the St Vrain rises in spring and early summer due to snow melt in the mountains. If you are interested in knowing the current rate of flow through town, the best site is the State's gage station for Lyons. <https://dwr.state.co.us/Tools/stations/SVCLYOCO?params=DISCHRG>
- At the direction of the BOT, the Town has eight overflow dry camping spots for campervans and self-contained pick up trucks with slide-ins during the summer months at the 2nd Ave Trailhead. The camping is limited to a maximum of three days. The Bohn Park hosts will manage the area and reservations.

PARKING PASS

Parking passes for both LaVern Johnson and Bohn Park are available to **residents** of the Town of Lyons. One free resident parking pass per household. Golf cars are considered vehicles. Non-residents may purchase a season parking pass for a flat rate of \$80 per vehicle. Sign up for your 2024 resident parking pass.

The parking fee for 2024 is \$2 per hour on weekdays and \$3 per hour on peak-season weekends. Parking fees are enforced every day.

GOLF CAR REGISTRATION

All Golf Cars (Low Speed Electric Vehicles) are required to be registered in Lyons, per the Lyons Municipal Code. Registration ensures that the vehicle is safe and has the correct mirrors and signage required. The program is for the safety of drivers and residents. In addition, the registration shows where golf cars are allowed and prohibited. For more information visit townoflyons.com/golfcar.

ROCKY MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK

Timed Entry Permit Reservations are required, along with a park pass or entrance fee, to enter Rocky Mountain National Park through October 14, 2024. There are two different access options for timed entry permits access with Bear Lake Road (Park Access+) and access without Bear Lake Road (Park Access).
