PUBLIC SAFETY REMINDERS

The Boulder County Sheriff's Office, with Town funding, has installed 6 Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) Flock cameras in Lyons. These cameras play a crucial role in aiding law enforcement to swiftly identify and apprehend suspects, and solve both personal and property crimes.

The deputies that serve the Town are dedicated to making a positive daily impact by promoting public safety, fostering strong relationships and delivering quality service. We remind residents to report any suspicious incidents to the non-emergency number, 303-441-4444. Emergencies should always be directed to 911. CONVERSION TO PAPERLESS BILLING

In an effort to reduce billing costs and to move forward with sustainability goals, the Town is converting to paperless billing. **A one-time \$5 credit** will be issued to customers who enroll with paperless billing through March 31, 2025. If you are already enrolled and receive your bill online, thank you! There will not be a retroactive credit.

The move to online billing will take effect April 1, 2025. Effective April 1, 2025 there will be a **\$2 monthly charge** for those customers who do not convert to paperless billing and continue to receive a paper bill. Payment may still be made with check, cash, direct checking account transfers as well as credit & debit cards. The online system also provides the ability to set automatic monthly payments, if desired, as well as access to the monthly billing history of your utility account.
