GOLF CAR REGISTRATION

In Lyons, golf cars are subject to specific regulations for safe operation on roadways, including having a driver with a valid driver's license, a rear-view mirror, seat belts, a slow moving vehicle sign (orange triangle) and a maximum speed of 20 mph. All Golf Cars (Low Speed Electric Vehicles) shall be registered in Lyons, per the Lyons Municipal Code. Remember to register a golf car to help ensure the vehicle has the necessary safety measures.

The program is for the safety of drivers as well as residents. In addition, the registration shows where golf cars are allowed and prohibited. For more information visit townoflyons.com/golfcar

APRIL DISCOUNT DOG DAYS

Per the Lyons Municipal Code, all residents living in the Town must obtain a license for their dog. It is essential for identifying lost dogs, vaccination verification, and for peace of mind in the community. Visit townoflyons.com/dog to get your dog's annual license.

1st dog license: \$30.00...but with the discount only \$20.00

2nd dog licenses: \$20.00... but with the discount only \$15.00

The town will need proof of your dog's current rabies vaccination. Please bring an extra copy for the town to keep. You are welcome to come to Town Hall with your proof of vaccination and complete the paperwork to license your dog. Remember to leash your dog too!

EMERGENCY SIREN TESTING

Boulder County has begun testing of the countywide emergency sirens in April. The audible siren tests take place on the first Monday of each month, from April through September and occur twice on each testing day, at 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Siren tests ensure that all systems and procedures are working properly during the season of peak flood and fire danger. Should Boulder County experience severe weather during one of the planned audible tests, the siren tests for that day may be cancelled.

Take precautions now, locking up trash and other food sources from bears, is important to prevent them from becoming habitually reliant on these sources for food. Bird feeders are also a direct and easy food source for bears. Bears become more of a risk when they associate humans with a food source. Garbage kills bears.
