WILDFIRE MITIGATION REBATE

Residents of the Town of Lyons may be eligible for a match of up to \$500 towards wildfire mitigation activities via a rebate. The Lyons program will utilize the same eligible mitigation activities as Boulder County but will also require an **Individual Home Assessment** which is offered by Wildfire Partners. Please note that Boulder County does NOT require a home assessment to claim a rebate.
